BUSINESSWOMAN, 49 Linda Susan Marbin Caplan , 49, died of breast cancer Sunday at her home in Center City.

Mrs. Caplan, a 1965 graduate of Cheltenham High School, studied business administration at Temple University and was business manager in the pulmonary department at the University of Pennsylvania Medical Center for about 10 years during the 1980s.

For the last seven years, she had been running her own electronic medical billing business, Medical Claims Associates, out of her home. She also did consulting work training doctors in developing fee schedules and managing their practices.

She was active with the Linda Creed Breast Cancer Foundation, the Wellness Community, and the Race for the Cure, an annual fund-raising event for breast cancer research. At the time of her death, she was working to develop a support group for women who have had a recurrence of cancer.

"She was a role model to other women with breast cancer," said her husband, Fred Caplan . "Even while getting chemo, she inspired others to make the most of their lives."

Besides her husband, she is survived by her son, Steven; mother, Marion Clayman; and a brother.

Services will be at 11 a.m. today at Goldsteins' Rosenberg's Raphael-Sacks, 6410 N. Broad St. Burial will be in Mount Lebanon Cemetery, Collingdale.
